

Additional Study at Stanley High School

Additional study is an essential component of your child's education and an integral part of the curriculum. It provides opportunities to further their understanding of the work they have undertaken in class and it also enables them to develop independent study skills.

At Stanley High additional study is set regularly and is an important factor in ensuring your child reaches their potential; additional study should be recorded in the students' planners. Students have access to help and support to complete their additional study after school or at the Homework Club in Room 38 at lunchtimes and after school 3.00pm to 4.00pm daily, where students have access to a computer and the internet.

The table below shows the amount of additional study hours per subject given to students over our two week timetable. The nature of the task varies from subject to subject and is set according to the student's ability and the department scheme of work.

Not all additional study will be written tasks but will include reading exercises and research topics to develop literacy and enquiry.
