Raffle

A youth group organised a raffle. They sold 65 tickets at £1 each, numbered 1 – 65

Each ticket that was a multiple of four won a prize costing £1.50

Each ticket ending in 5 won a prize costing £2.20

How much profit was made by the youth group?



ANSWER

REVENUE: $65 \times £1 = £65$

COSTS: $24 \times £1.50 = £36$

$+ 7 \times £2.20 = £15.40$

Total Cost = £51.40

PROFIT = $£65 - £51.50$

= £13.60
