

Good Morning Stanley families

We are really looking forward to re-introducing all students back into school from September. Usually arrangements for this would be quite straight forward for the start of the year; luckily, they are still straight forward but they are different.

Attached are the details about returning and some FAQ for students, please go through these documents with your child(ren). Should you have any further questions following reading all of the information please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Here are some key pieces of information that you MUST be aware of:

The following measures are in compliance with Government and Union Guidelines, they allow in-school tracking of student movement, limited student contact and allow Stanley High School to maintain a broad and balanced curriculum. We see this as a temporary measure which will alter as the health of the community does.

**Year 7 Start on 2<sup>nd</sup> September at 9am please come to the front of school**

**First day back re-integration to school – Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**

Year 8 to 11 will be in school on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September for a reintegration assembly only. This decision has been made due to the fast-changing pace of guidance updates. When September comes, we may be in a further model of schooling from what we have planned now. Attendance to this assembly is imperative as we will tell the students the most up to date plans and answer any questions they may have.

**Students to enter through the main entrance and sanitise hands on entry.**

Year 8	9:00am – 10:00am
Year 9	10:30am – 11:30am
Year 10	12:00pm – 1:00pm
Year 11	1:30pm – 2:30pm

Students will be expected to leave school and return home immediately following their assembly.

**Staggered start and finish times from Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September**

On a normal school day Year **7, 8** and **9** will start at **9:00am** and finish at **3:10pm**

Year **10** and **11** start at **8:40am** and finish at **2:40pm**.

Students to arrive as close to their start time as possible and leave site as soon as their day ends.

**Learning Zones**

Our school has been split into 5 daily learning zones. Students will be in a year group sized bubble and will be in a different zone each day. This prevents bubbles mixing and allows deep cleaning of zones after school.

Each daily learning zone has a separate entry/exit door and a dedicated hand wash area. Fine details attached.

**Uniform**

From Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September we expect all students in full uniform. Please send your child with a note to explain any missing items. This will allow us to support you where possible.

One day a week, depending on your child's year group they must come to school in PE kit and bring a spare PE Kit or Sports clothing on that day in case there is a need for a change.

### **Food**

Where possible please send your child with a packed lunch. Lunches from the canteen will be ordered on a weekly basis from a limited menu and delivered to daily learning zones. Please ensure ParentPay is topped up with enough money for the week. If students must bring cash into school, they will only be able to access the pay machines on the following days:

There will be no breakfast or break time provision in school. Please send your child into school with a snack if they require one at break time and enough water for the full day.

### **Lockers**

Lockers cannot be used during this time and if not already emptied must be done after school during the first week, when students are in the same zone as their locker.

### **Languages for Year 8 students**

Due to missing a significant amount of language time Year 8 will continue with all three languages during this temporary phase. We will re-confirm language options before adopting a permanent learning structure.
