Last week, our Year 7 football team competed in a Sefton Schools Football Tournament which was hosted by Holy Family High School. They came up against some of the strongest schools in Sefton and went all the way to the end of the tournament playing back-to-back 20-minute matches.

Out of the 6 schools who competed, we finished 3rd overall which is a great achievement when up against some strong schools. Special mention must go to Noah who was voted player of the tournament by the referees who were in charge of the three pitches.

On Tuesday, our Year 8 Sports Hall Athletics team represented North Sefton at the Merseyside Finals which consisted of 16 borough winners competing to become overall Merseyside champions.

Our students competed in a range of different track and field events which consisted of sprints, endurance, throwing and jumping. The PE department are extremely proud to say that our team finished 4th out of 16, meaning they are the 4th strongest team across Merseyside after accumulating a total of 241 points over each of the events that had taken place.

The winners finished on 250 points meaning Stanley were not too far behind being the strongest. Special mention to Adam (2 lap individual) and Brandon (4 lap individual) who both won their heat races and also when teaming together, won the 4x2 lap relay race. The PE department would like to say a massive congratulations for this tremendous achievement.
