Year 9 have been working on the theme 'landscapes' using traditional watercolour washes for backgrounds and then using tone to draw their silhouettes.

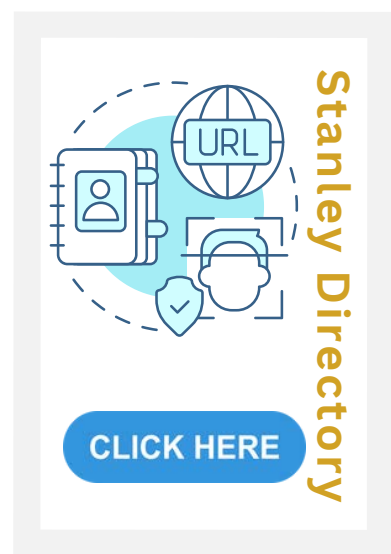
Ellie decided she wanted to be a little bit different and have a seascape theme. Look at the amazing detail - well done.
