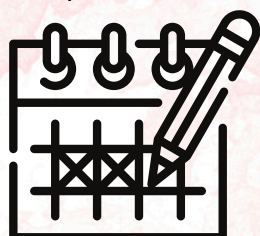
We had one of the biggest turnouts for a long time and it was wonderful to catch up with students and find out what they have been up to and how they are getting on in college.
