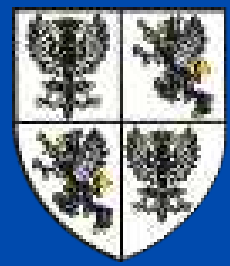

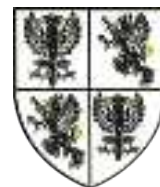

After months of aggressive chemotherapy, surgery, a tracheostomy, back at school, back in the gym and back swimming.

Now it's our turn to come together as a community and give something back. To thank Alder Hey Oncology Ward for their incredible care, and to support every child still fighting their own battle against cancer.
